Bisphosphonates Pre-Administering Requirements

A class of drugs called bisphosphonates (some of these: Reclast, Prolia, Zometa, Xgeva) can cause osteonecrosis of the jaw. Because of this, a dentist's letter of clearance indicating that the patient is in good oral health to have this drug is a requirement. As well, we need to have the following checks below.
